What to know about the novel CORONAVIRUS

How is it transmitted?
Via respiratory droplets.
Coronavirus can spread through contact with hands. Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
Incubation is between 2 and 14 days.

Preventive measures
Cough or sneeze into a disposable tissue or covering mouth and nose with elbow.
Wash hands frequently with soap and water or alcohol-based solution.
Avoid contact with others if you have a respiratory infection.

Frequent signs and symptoms
Fever
Cough
Shortness of breath

Emergency Information:
If you have any of these symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath) and have been in an affected area, or if you have been in contact with someone with the illness.
Stay at home and call 061.

The Regional Health Ministry strengthens the measures to prevent the propagation of COVID-19 and makes the use of face masks mandatory in public spaces.

The Regional Ministry for Health and Consumer Affairs has drawn up a resolution to strengthen the measures designed to prevent the propagation of COVID-19, thus, the use of face masks will be made mandatory in public.

Given the pandemic's evolution and because it has been seen that the situation in a specific region can change suddenly if a large outbreak occurs, it has been considered appropriate to strengthen the measures to prevent the propagation of COVID-19.

Amongst other measures, the resolution makes it mandatory to use face masks in public. This includes buildings with a public use, and places that provides any service to the public. Exceptions, however, include pools, beaches, and dining establishments when eating and drinking.

Additionally, there is a limit in capacity for social and family gatherings, which is set at a maximum of 70 people outdoors and 30 indoors. The occupancy limit in taxis has been removed and it is still mandatory to wear face masks for occupants in private vehicles when they do not live together. Likewise, the limit of 25 people in non-regulated educational centres has been removed.
